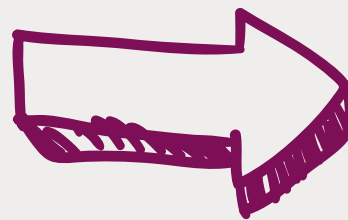

Digital EmpowHer

Ballymun Job Centre | Dublin

Digital EmpowHer addresses the critical challenges women face in the labour market, including limited advancement opportunities, wage disparities, and caregiving responsibilities, by emphasising the need for digital skills to enhance their employment and training prospects. This project fosters a supportive environment through peer-led, participatory collaboration, focusing on digital skill development and the networking to empower women in their careers.

Unlocking the P0tential of Women in social EntRepreneurship (U.Power)

By combining an online training course with one to one mentoring, U.Power endeavours to empower social entrepreneurs to generate and develop an idea for a social enterprise. The project also aims to equip adult educators with coaching skills to support women in entrepreneurship, while raising awareness on gender equality challenges.

Woman Connecting Europe

The project aims to empower migrant women in Ireland and Greece by equipping them with digital and soft skills for socio-professional integration, such as basic IT skills, web development and coding.

It also fosters social interactions between EU citizens and migrants, while supporting humanitarian efforts across Europe.

Digital Entrepreneurship for Women (DEW) addresses the under-representation of women in entrepreneurship in the EU labour market.
