



## #EDLComp24

Léargas' Languages Programme brings you a new European Day of Languages Competition and exciting prizes! This year's competition is held in conjunction with **eTwinning**, the online community for schools in Europe. This partnership celebrates collaboration and exchange between schools in different EU countries and promotes creativity and innovation in language teaching and learning.

### The Prize

Five winning schools will each receive three Chromebooks.

### Entry Criteria

- Only schools in the Republic of Ireland can enter the competition.
- Create a language-related project and register it on the [eTwinning Platform](#) between 9 September and 15 November 2024, adding the hashtag **#EDLComp24** to the title. **Only projects using the hashtag will be entered to the competition.**
- If you don't have an eTwinning partner, look for one on the [eTwinning Partner Finding](#) page.
- eTwinning projects must be related to language learning or have a prominent linguistic aspect which enhances and develops the language skills of the learner. **Primary- and Post-Primary school projects through the medium of Irish or English as an additional language are eligible and welcome to apply.**
- You can create a project on a theme that is of most interest to your students, or choose the following suggested theme:

#### ➤ Languages for Peace

- The project partners must have common goals and a collaborative work plan.
- The Irish-based applying teachers must have made significant contributions to the project. This must be visible on the eTwinning platform. The minimum requirement is to use and react to partners' materials.
- Projects can last between one week and an academic year.
- Although several projects from the same school can enter the competition, only one project per school can win the competition.

### Selection Criteria

- Projects should be original and creative.
- Projects must demonstrate communication, collaboration and exchange between partner schools, particularly using the target language(s).
- The eTwinning platform should be used creatively to stimulate language learning.

### Timeline

- All projects must be registered on [eTwinning Platform](#) with the #EDLComp24 hashtag in the title by 15 November 2024.
- Winners will be notified by the middle of December 2024.
